Welcome to the sixth biennial UCSI University International Piano Festival and Competition 2024 (UCSI IPFC). As a leading music institution in Malaysia, the Institute of Music (IMus) at UCSI University is proud to present this exciting and enriching event to pianists up to 28 years old. Since 2014, IPFC has set the stage for talented pianists to showcase their skills as well as to expand their network by engaging with pianists and judges from Malaysia and beyond. This year, we received a total of 145 contestants, both locally and internationally. Apart from creating a platform for young musicians to showcase their talent, we, as Malaysia's top music school, earnestly see the need to cultivate the art of piano playing in Malaysia. In order to aspire to a higher level of performance, we have set our standard to be on par with some of the international competitions. This competition also serves to educate teachers and parents about the nature and the processes involved in preparing their students and children respectively, for an international piano competition. As for prizes, in addition to cash and receiving constructive feedback from our esteemed judges, participants have the chance to earn performance opportunities and pursue further studies at both national and international music festivals as part of the prizes.

In an effort to promote new music in Malaysia, we have been collaborating with the Malaysian Composers Collective (MCC) to showcase the works of Malaysian composers since IPFC 2020. This year, we have continued the tradition with two commissioned works by Malaysian composers Mr. Lim Yu-Yao and Mr. Tan Zhi Yong. The duo won the Free Hand Festival co-organized by MCC and IMus in 2023. These pieces will have their world premiere during the final round in June.

IPFC 2024 involves the efforts of many individuals. CHEONG YEW **CHOONG**

Cheong Yew Choong holds his Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctorate Degrees from West Virginia University (USA) under full scholarship and graduate assistantship. His teachers include Prof. Dr. Peter Amstutz and Prof. Dr. P'ng Tean Hwa. Despite hearing impairment, Yew Choong is a prizewinner of several competitions: Music Teachers National Association Collegiate Artist Piano Competition in the State of West Virginia, WVU's Annual Young Artists Auditions and the VSA Arts's International Young Soloists Award.

Among the highlights of solo performances are appearances at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and National Institutes of Health in Washington D.C., Thailand's First Mozart Piano Competition and Festival, the International Piano Festival by People with Disabilities in Osaka and Vienna, UCSI International Piano Festival and Competition, Free Hand Contemporary Composers Piano Festival and KL Piano Gala Concerts.

As a scholar, Yew Choong has presented lecture recitals on historical performance practice, at the international and local conferences in Australia, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Thailand, and Switzerland (online edition). His scholarly contributions include articles about historically informed perspectives of dynamics and accents in Mahidol Music Journal and Research Publication of Bern University of the Arts. As an educator, he has played multi-faceted roles: the Chair of the UCSI University Piano Pedagogy Conference 2023, invited adjudicatorpresenter for several piano competitions and masterclasses, and a member of Mahidol Music Journal's Editorial Board.

Yew Choong is currently Associate Professor at UCSI University Institute of Music in Kuala Lumpur.



KHOO KHE SIN

Khoo Khe Sin received her B.Mus. degree from UCSI University with a certification from the University of Newcastle (Australia), as well as her M.M. and D.M.A. degrees from West Virginia University (USA). Her teachers include Prof. Dr. Peter Amstutz and Prof. Dr. Tean Hwa P'ng.

A multi-award recipient, Khe Sin had served as graduate assistant to the WVU Opera and Theater department, as well as studio accompanist and piano instructor at WVU. Her achievements include winning the 2006 WVU Young Artist Competition, as well as serving as staff accompanist at the National Association of Teachers of Singing (NATS) Tri-States Regional Competition (2012 and 2013), and at the International Flute Symposium at WVU (2012).

Since returning to Malaysia in 2014, Khe Sin has been active in the performing arts scene, collaborating with both local and international artistes and production companies. As an educator, she teaches privately and serves as an adjunct lecturer at UCSI University Institute of Music in Kuala Lumpur.



YULING HUANG-DAVIE

Dr. Yuling Huang-Davie is an Assistant Professor who heads the collaborative piano program in the School of Music and Performing Arts at the University of Louisiana-Lafayette. She earned her doctorate in Collaborative Piano from Florida State University, where she was an assistant music coach for the Florida State Opera. Professor Huang-Davie earned her Master of Music degree in Piano Performance from Shenandoah Conservatory in Virginia after graduating in Piano Performance at Xi'an Conservatory (China) with a baccalaureate.

Her performances and masterclass engagements have brought her to lecture halls and performance stages in Washington D.C., the University of West Virginia, University of Memphis, James Madison University, Shenandoah University, University of Florida, Tulane University, and Louisiana State University, among others. Dr. Huang-Davie's concert performances have aired on National Public Radio (NPR) stations in Florida and Louisiana and a recording of her piano and flute collaborations is available on Centaur Records on a CD titled Apparitions and Whimsies (CRC 2689).

Dr. Huang-Davie was awarded a Fulbright Teaching Scholarship to UCSI (Malaysia 2023-24). This achievement follows awards for Outstanding Mentor (Graduate School, University of Louisiana at Lafayette), Distinguished Alumna for Outstanding Professional Achievement (Shenandoah Conservatory), and the twice-honored recipient of the Marion Park Lewis Foundation for the Arts and the Tallahassee Music Guild Scholarship.



AMANDA LEE HING

Dr. Amanda Lee Hing is an accomplished pianist and a dedicated educator. She is currently the Assistant Music Department Chair and Professor of Piano at Southwestern Assemblies of God University (SAGU) in Texas, U.S.A. Her previous academic roles include faculty positions at Washington and Jefferson College in Pennsylvania and Glenville State University in West Virginia.

Dr. Lee Hing has been appointed as the Artistic Director for the Waxahachie Symphony Association and holds positions on the boards of the Frisco and Dallas Music Teachers Associations. She had served as the Faculty Chair of the Texas Music Teachers Association (TMTA) Collegiate Chapters and Vice President of the Arlington Music Teachers Association.

Dr. Lee Hing has garnered numerous accolades, including winning the Piano Texas International Academy and Festival Teachers Concerto Competition (organized in collaboration with the Van Cliburn Foundation) and making her debut performance with the Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra as a soloist in 2007. In addition, Dr. Lee Hing was the winner of the West Virginia University Young Artist Concerto Competition, recognized as the WVU Outstanding Senior, and honored as the WVU Chancellor's Scholar and a Southern Regional Education Board Doctoral Scholar.

Her commitment to music education is vividly reflected in her role as a presenter at the Music Teachers National Association (MTNA) National Conferences and the TMTA State Conventions. She has also led the SAGU collegiate chapter to win the prestigious MTNA Benjamin Whitten Collegiate Chapter of the Year National Award. She holds D.M.A., M.M., B.M. from West Virginia University. Her teachers include Dr. James Miltenberger, Loo Bang Hean, Veronica Leong, and Josephine Lim.



MORAG YONG

Morag Yong was born in Kuching, Malaysia. She entered the Royal College of Music (RCM), London to study piano with Peter Element. After graduating with First Class and also obtaining the ARCM Teaching Diploma, Morag continued at RCM to obtain the Master of Music degree in Performance Studies. Whilst at college, she won numerous prizes including the Marjorie & Arnold Ziff Prize for the most outstanding Graduation Recital. Her education in London has been made possible with the generous support of the Sarawak Foundation, The Countess of Munster Musical Trust and The Charles Napper Trust.

Morag has considerable experience in solo, accompaniment and chamber music performance. Since returning to Kuala Lumpur, she has devoted her time to music education, having taught at Yamaha Academy of Arts & Music and University Malaya. She teaches privately, besides examining and conducting masterclasses. She has also been invited to adjudicate in competitions including the Yamaha Piano Prize, Hong Kong Asia Pacific Piano Competition, Malaysian Piano Competition, UCSI University International Piano Festival & Competition, Euroasia Youth Music Festival and Young Artists Music Festival. Morag is currently adjunct lecturer at The Institute of Music, UCSI University.



SU-YEN CHEE

Malaysian pianist Su-yen Chee has established herself both as a soloist and chamber musician. She has given solo and collaborative recitals in the United States, Hong Kong, Japan, China, Korea, Thailand, Singapore and Malaysia.

Recent performances include an all-Debussy recital commemorating the centenary of the composer's passing. She also performed Beethoven's Concerto No.1 with the Selangor Philharmonic Orchestra in their "Beethoven Complete Concertos" series. She has also premiered works of contemporary Malaysian composers and participated in the Soundbridge Contemporary Festival and Free Hand Contemporary Piano Festival. Su-yen is also in demand as an accompanist, and has worked extensively with both instrumentalists and vocalists.

Besides performing, she dedicates her time to teaching. Her students have won prizes in local and regional competitions and she is also sought after as an adjudicator, most recently for the MIA Young Musician Competition, 2nd Hong Kong International Competition for Young Pianists- Malaysia round, 14th Hong Kong (Asia Pacific) Malaysia Preliminary Competition, UCSI University International Piano Festival and Competition, Virtual International Music Competition 2020 and E-Artium Piano Competition.

Su-yen is a graduate of Indiana University (Bloomington) and the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts, where she completed her MMus and BMus (1st class honours) degrees respectively. Her major teachers include Karen Shaw, Michel Block and Gabriel Kwok. Throughout her studies she has also participated in masterclasses and benefited from lessons given by, amongst others Vladimir Feltsman, Fou Ts'ong, Regina Smendzianka, Constance Keene, Michel Dalberto, Christopher Elton, Martin Roscoe, Lee Kum Sing and Li Ming Qiang.

Currently, Su-yen is an adjunct lecturer at UCSI University, ASWARA and maintains a private studio.



JAZ TAN

Jaz Tan graduated from University of Western Ontario, Canada with a Master of Music degree under full scholarship and graduate assistantship. She specializes in piano, harp and aural skills education. She was formerly Assistant Professor, working as the Head of Classical Music Degree Program in UCSI University, Kuala Lumpur. She now works as adjunct lecturer coaching piano at the university. She is also appointed the branch manager of Rave Harps KL Centre, overseeing harp education in Klang Valley, Malaysia.

Apart from being a solo pianist and harpist, she also works as a collaborative musician and performed in many choral, opera and musical events/productions. Jaz Tan has adjudicated international and local piano competitions and conducted masterclasses and workshops. Among those were adjudicator for an International Music Festival in Indonesia (2015), UCSI International Piano Festival & Competition (2018 and 2020), 2nd & 3rd E-Artium Piano Competition and Festival (2022/2023) and Singapore Raffles International Music Festival (2023).

With proven teaching guidance and coaching skills, Jaz has guided many young musicians, often scoring distinctions in music exams and receiving awards in local and international competitions. In recent years, she has reached out to many families providing quality early childhood music education and nurturing a new generation of musicians.



LIM PEI SIEN

Lim Pei Sien is known for her aptitude to collaborate well with other musicians. She has performed in recitals and music festivals in Malaysia, Brunei, Thailand, Austria and the USA as a chamber musician as well as a soloist.

Born and raised in Kota Bharu, Kelantan, Pei Sien currently resides in Brunei Darussalam with her family. She is a piano tutor and an accompanist at Jerudong International School. She has been involved in the school's musical productions as a rehearsal pianist as well as a pianist in the pit band. She performs frequently in school and in concerts organized by the Brunei Music Society. As a clinician, she recently presented a virtual seminar on How to Make Practising Music Fun and Engaging for Children to a group of instrumental teachers.

Pei Sien was an Assistant Professor at UCSI University from 2005 - 2013. She was a former staff accompanist of Interlochen Arts Camp, Michigan and American Institute of Musical Studies, Graz.

Under the guidance of Dr. James Miltenberger and Dr. Connie Arrau Sturm, Pei Sien received her Doctor of Musical Arts in piano performance from West Virginia University. She was granted scholarships and graduate assistantships throughout her studies at WVU. Pei Sien also won numerous accolades from WVU, notably the distinguished Higher Education Resource Fund Top-Off Fellowship and the Outstanding Music Student Award. Her former tutors were Ng Mei Fong, Tan Hui Ming and Lau Yin Ming.



HO SU HAN

Ho Su Han is currently a lecturer at the UCSI Institute of Music where she also serves as the chamber music coordinator. She was the vice chairperson of the 3rd Piano Pedagogy Conference at UCSI in 2023. Outside of UCSI, Su Han had conducted guest lectures on the topics of collaborative piano and chamber music in University Malaya and University of Louisiana at Lafayette. She was also a piano presenter for Trinity College London (Malaysia) from 2021-2024, presenting lectures on topics such as performance practice, playing tips, and stylistic interpretation based on the Trinity piano exam repertoire. As an adjudicator, she had judged in the 2023 and 2022 Kuen Cheng High School Piano Competitions; as well as the 6th International Piano Festival and Competition at UCSI in 2022.

Su Han had participated in various music festivals such as Brevard Music Center Summer Institute and Festival, Castleman Quartet Program, Texas Music Festival, Zodiac Music Academy and Festival, and Free Hand Festival. A native of Johor, Su Han graduated from the Cleveland Institute of Music with a Doctor of Musical Arts in Collaborative Piano as a student of Anita Pontremoli. She obtained her Master of Music in Collaborative Piano from University of Houston under the tutelage of Timothy Hester; and Bachelor of Music in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from Universiti Sains Malaysia, where she studied piano under Dr. Jason Tye Kong



YONG SUE YI

Yong Sue Yi has received her Master of Music in Piano Performance from Peabody Conservatory of Music (USA) under the tutelage of Marian Hahn with full scholarship. She is the first Malaysian pianist graduating from the Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music in Singapore, with a BMus degree (Honours) in Piano Performance. She was awarded a full scholarship under the tutelage of Albert Tiu for her four-year studies in the Conservatory. Sue Yi has worked as a chamber musician under the guidance of Dr. Thomas Hecht, Katherine Jacobson Fleisher, David Takeno, Zhang Jin Min, and Keng-Yuan Tseng. She has also performed in master classes, working with international concert artists such as John O'Conor, Stephen Savage, and Ian Holtman.

As a performer, Sue Yi has won the second prize of the HSBC Classic Solo Piano Competition in 2008. She has been active as a collaborative pianist and is one of the core members of Ensemble Virama. Among her performance highlights are "All Creatures Great & Small", a collaboration with the Bentley Music Academy Youth Orchestra and Ensemble 24+ where she appeared as one of the soloist in Saint-Saën's Carnival of the Animals (June 2019), Ensemble Virama "Murakami-Hear the Wind Sing" (May 2019), Voyage: The Song and The Gallery—both concerts by YST alumni (August 2018). Sue Yi is also much sought-after competition adjudicator and clinician for master classes and workshops.

Sue Yi is currently a part-time lecturer in UCSI University and a member of the Piano Faculty at Bentley Music Academy.



CHIEW ZHI HONG

Hailing from Kajang, Chiew Zhi Hong's musical journey began when he was enrolled into Yamaha's Junior Music Course (JMC) at age 4, under Mr Gary Wong. He was the youngest in his class when he continued with the Junior Special Advanced Course (JSAC) and finishing at age 14 with the Special Advanced Course (SAC) and a Yamaha Grade 5 teaching certification under the tutelage of Mr Lim Hock Seng.

At age 8, Zhi Hong started having lessons with Maestro Ng Chong Lim alongside his Yamaha courses. After finishing his SPM, he started studying overseas at the Freiburg University of Music in 2014, graduating with his Bachelor's Degree in Piano Performance and Piano Pedagogy in 2018 under the tutelage of Professor Pi-hsien Chen and Professor Hardy Rittner. He continued under Professor Rittner before graduating his Masters with high honours in early 2020. He then studied at the Trossingen University of Music under the tutelage of Professor Volker Stenzl, and concluded his Soloist Diploma (Konzertexamen) in 2022, with graduation recitals that came with raving remarks.

Among his achievements include a Trinity LTCL High Scorer Award in Solo Piano in 2011 along with an invitation to perform at the awards ceremony, performances in the 1st Asia Grand Piano Concert, and at University Malaya as an invited special guest. He has won prizes in the inaugural Steinway Malaysia Youth Piano Competition (3rd), Silver and Bronze Prizes in the Piano Concerto category at the 4th (Silver) and 5th (Bronze) ASEAN Chopin Piano Competitions.



HEAH ZI-LING

Born and raised in Penang, Dr Heah Zi-Ling is currently a Full-Time Lecturer in Music at UCSI University. Zi-Ling received her Doctoral and Master's degrees in Piano Performance from West Virginia University and Bowling Green State University in the USA. Prior to pursuing her studies in the USA, she also graduated with a bachelor's degree in law

Zi-Ling held various job positions during her postgraduate studies in the USA, including Adjunct Lecturer as Collaborative Pianist and Graduate Assistant in Choral Accompanying. In addition to collaborating with instrumentalists and vocalists, she also taught piano in community school programs in the USA and students who are taking piano as their minor instrument for their undergraduate degree in music.

Her interest in music research lies primarily in French Piano Music as her final DMA dissertation, titled "Evocations of Nature in Selected Piano Works by Debussy" was subsequently awarded the Mary T. Ferrer Award for excellence in DMA research.

She currently teaches individual piano lessons and coaches chamber music ensembles in UCSI University. The undergraduate and graduate courses which she teaches in UCSI include music history, and piano pedagogy.



YSAN SUIT YIN

Assistant Professor Ysan Suit Yin is the Head of the Classical Music Degree at UCSI University. She is a very dedicated teacher, and her academic achievements are mainly in teaching, ATCL (Teaching), LTCL (Teaching), LRSM (Teaching) and she was one of the first in Southeast Asia to be awarded the Fellowship of the Royal Schools of Music (FRSM) in teaching. Suit Yin currently also holds the role of examiner for the Classical & Jazz panel, Trinity College of London.

While living in London, Suit Yin studied with Professor Vanessa Latarche, late Professor Dr. Colin Kingsley, late Dennis Lee and Toh Chee Hung. Suit Yin received an exemption from undergraduate study, hence a place was offered in London College of Music with bursary for a Master's Degree study under the guidance of Piano Professor Andrew Zolinsky. Her teachers also included Simon Rigby, Philip Mead and Dr. Anna McCready.

Suit Yin is frequently invited to be the adjudicator in the UCSI International Piano Festival and Competition since 2014 till present day. She was also invited to adjudicate the Asia International Piano Competition in 2015, and periodically adjudicate Piano Competition in High Schools in Malaysia. Since 2018, she was frequently invited to judge piano competition and presented piano masterclasses in Indonesia and Singapore.

Suit Yin contributed a write-up "Tribute to Professor Dr. Colin Kingsley" to European Piano Teacher-Piano Professional-spat UK and was published in the April 2021, Issue 56. Suit Yin performed in the Free Hand 2022: 2nd Malaysian Contemporary Composers Piano Festival. Recently, she had a joint recital with Mathias Boegner, a German/Swiss violinist at UCSI University and at SOTA recital hall in Singapore.



LEONG MANN YEE

Leong Mann Yee is a Master of Philosophy (Performance) graduate from the Royal Northern College of Music, who obtained her Master of Music from Birmingham Conservatoire. Her teaching area focuses on piano, music theory, aural, ensemble coaching and music research. She was previously an Assistant Professor and Head of the Foundation in Music program at UCSI University, Institute of Music.

She had participated in the RNCM Ravel Festival 2007 and the International Asia Chopin Piano Competition in Tokyo 2004. Since 2011, she had performed several piano duet and duo recitals, including a lecture-recital at the National Taichung University of Education.

Apart from teaching, Mann Yee has served as a guest adjudicator in the International Piano Festival and Competition (IPFC) 2014 and 2022, and in regional music competitions including Muar Youth Piano Competition 2018 and 2019. She has been invited to conduct piano workshops and masterclasses for music schools in Medan and Surabaya, Indonesia.

She is currently an adjunct lecturer at UCSI University and an early childhood music educator.



P'NG TEAN HWA Jury Chair

P'ng Tean Hwa is Professor and Director of the Institute of Music at UCSI University, where he has served since 1997. At UCSI University, he is a long-standing member of the University Examination Board, a member of the University Council in 2016-2020, and the Chair of the Senate Learning and Teaching Committee in 2007-2010. He was pivotal in establishing UCSI University's International Piano Festival and Competition as well as the Piano Pedagogy Conference, which are held biennially in alternate years since 2014.

As a performer, Tean Hwa has appeared in numerous public concerts as a soloist as well as collaborative pianist in Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, South Korea, Hungary, and the USA. As a clinician, he has presented numerous lectures, workshops, and seminars to both piano teachers and the general audience. He has conducted many piano masterclasses, most recently in Armenia as a Guest International Distinguished Professor in 2022. He is frequently invited to serve as a guest examiner and to adjudicate competitions, including the Asia International Piano Competition in Taiwan and in South Korea, and the 5th German Irmler (Qingdao) International Piano Competition in Qingdao, China. He has also been invited to contribute as a blind peer reviewer for several music journals.

Prof. P'ng holds doctoral, master's and bachelor's degrees and the FTCL and LTCL diplomas in piano performance, a chemical engineering degree, and a Postgraduate Diploma in Tertiary Teaching. He is a life member of the national scholastic honor society of Phi Kappa Phi in the USA.

Gabriel Kwok is a Steinway Artist and Steinway Honorary Professor. He was the Music Director of The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts / Radio Television Hong Kong 'Beethoven 32 Piano Sonatas' project. In 2014, he was awarded Medal of Honour from the Hong Kong Government for his contribution to piano education in Hong Kong.

He has been invited to give lectures, conduct piano masterclasses and has served as a jury member in many piano competitions in Vietnam and abroad. His students have won top awards in many national and international competitions.

He is currently a Head of Piano Department at the Ho Chi Minh City Conservatory of Music, Vietnam.



LIAO CHIAO-HAN

All-around pianist Liao Chiao-han, a native of Taiwan, is an active performer of solo and chamber music throughout the United States, Taiwan, Japan, and Finland. Ms. Liao is a graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music, the Juilliard School and Yale School of Music. She participated in XIV International Frederic Chopin Competition in Warsaw in 2000, and Internationaler Musikwettbewerb der ARD Munchen in

In 2007, Ms. Liao established Han Arts to promote classical music and nurture new talents in the music industry. 2022 Ms. Liao new solo album "Chiao-han Liao~Chopin and Granados"was nominated the best performance prize and the best recording prize of the 34th Golden Melody Awards for Traditional Music and Art. Ms.Liao's other solo albums are "Encore" and "Xi Shi Fantasy" complete piano solo works of Fu Tong Wong.

After returning to Taiwan from 2002, Chiao-han has played more than 600 concerts including solo, concerto, chamber music, contemporary music and vocal performances. In 2011 she has participated in music production of Movie "Make up" and "Father's lullby". Ms.Liao is the jury of all the important competitions in Taiwan. She was invited to be the faculty of many music festivals, such as International Mastro Piano Festival, Asian Aegean Sea Summer Piano Master Classes and Enlightenment Summer Music Festival. Chiao-han Liao currently resides in Taiwan and is on the faculty at National Taiwan Normal University.



LIM CHAN KIAT

Chan Kiat Lim has performed solo and chamber recitals in Canada, China, Germany, Greece, Italy, Jamaica, Malaysia, Romania, and throughout the United States including solo performances at Music at Penn Alps Concert Series in Maryland and twice at Steinway Hall, New York City.

As a performer, Lim champions music beyond the canon of classical art music, and is an enthusiastic interpreter of new and underrepresented music, particularly works by American composers. He was awarded the Louisiana Division of the Arts Grant to release a CD An American Kaleidoscope, featuring two world-premieres by musical giants and Pulitzer Prize winners, William Bolcom and Ned Rorem. Endorsing Lim's performance on this CD, Rorem writes that "His aims are rare and high, and his means are perfect."

A pedagogue and clinician, he is an active presenter at international and national music conferences on performance and pedagogical topics. Lim is co-authored of eNovativePiano, an online multimedia curriculum for piano instruction and elearning. Its multimedia content and transformative approach point towards a new direction in piano instruction, and was the recipient of the 2021 MTNA-Frances Clark Keyboard Pedagogy Award.

Lim is an Endowed Professor of Piano at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette where teaches piano performance, keyboard literature, class piano, and the heads the Keyboard Studies Area. In 2015, Lim received the UL-Lafayette Distinguished Professor Award and the Louisiana Music Teachers Association Outstanding Teacher Award. In 2020, he was honored as a MTNA Foundation Fellow.



NING AN

Pianist Ning An is a rare pianist who has been hailed as a musician who "combines a flawless technique and mastery of the instrument with an expressive power that is fueled by profound and insightful understanding." (New York Concert Review) His top prizes from the Queen Elizabeth, Santander, and William Kapell Piano Competitions led to performances at Carnegie's Weill Recital Hall, Salle Verdi (Milan), National Centre for the Performing Arts (Beijing, China), and many more.

Since making his orchestral debut at the age of 16 with the Cleveland Orchestra, Mr. An has been a featured soloist with orchestras such as the London Symphony Orchestra, Moscow Radio Symphony Orchestra, Baltimore Symphony, the Stuttgart Philharmonic, and the Warsaw Philharmonic under the batons of conductors such as Vladimir Fedosseyev, Jorg-Peter Weigle, Rafael Fruhbeck de Burgos, and Others Mr. An has been invited to perform at numerous festivals, including the International Chopin Festival in Duszinski, Poland, the Gina Bachauer Piano Festival in Salt Lake City, the Bourglinster Festival in Luxembourg, and the Interlaken Music Festival in Switzerland.

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Commissioned Composer Biography



LIM YU YAO

Lim Yu-Yao (b. 1997) is a Malaysian composer, arranger and educator currently pursuing his Master's degree in theory and composition at National Taiwan Normal University under the guidance of Prof. Chien Shan-Hua.

During his time in Taiwan, he actively participated in numerous intercollegiate concerts, and his compositions were featured in various concerts and recitals. As an alumnus of Soochow University, he was entrusted with arranging orchestral pieces for the university's 122nd-anniversary concert held at the National Concert Hall in 2022. Notably, in 2023, his wind band composition titled "Buaian Kenangan", commissioned by the klpac Symphonic Band, had its premiere at the concert "Childhood Revisited" at the Kuala Lumpur Performing Arts Center and at the Chiayi City International Band Festival in Taiwan. Furthermore, in the same year, he is also one of the two winners of the Free Hand 2023: Third Malaysian Contemporary Composers Piano Festival.

With frequent commissions, Lim excels in composing and arranging works for diverse instrumentations. His compositions are notably shaped by his self-taught jazz piano skills, which heavily influence the majority of his pieces. Beyond his compositional endeavours, Lim enthusiastically contributes to education, serving as a music educator. He focuses on teaching music theory, composition, and jazz piano.



YONG TAN

Yong Tan is a Malaysian media composer, concert composer, and producer. He believes that music can carry not only emotion but also information. Therefore, his works often investigate issues of philosophy, social, and environmental.

In October 2023, his piano solo "9 Etudes for Piano" won the FreeHand 3rd Malaysian Contemporary Composers Piano Festival call for score, and was commissioned to write a new work for the UCSI International Piano Festival Competition 2024. In June 2023, his commissioned orchestra work "Dots" was performed at the Penang Performing Art Center in Malaysia as part of the Rondo Festival. In 2022, his piano solo composition "Sad Fact" was selected for the FreeHand 2nd Malaysian Contemporary Composers Piano Festival call for score. In 2021, he won the UITM Tunku Zain Piano Trio Composition Competition with his piano trio "My little Sister 'asking' for Present"; and the Kyle Pearl 2nd Annual Open Call with his cello solo 1 = 1+1.

He has also participated in some music festivals including the 2023 SoundBridge Festival Malaysia, the 2023 Atlantic Music Festival in the US, the 2023 Young Composers Initiative hosted by The Rondo Production, the 2022 Emerge Virtual Workshop hosted by the Julius Quartet, the 2021 SMCC SoundBridge Virtual Festival Malaysia, the 2021 Malaysia Young Composer Workshop, and the 2021 Musical Exchange Program hosted by The Rondo Production.

Yong Tan holds a dual degree in concert composition and media composition from West Chester University of Pennsylvania. He is now pursuing his master's degree (class of 2025) in screen scoring at New York University.
